RESPONSIVE READING: *1 Corinthians 11: 23—29, 32 (CEV). The Lord's Supper*

LEADER: *He took some bread in his hands. Then after he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is given for you. Eat this and remember me."*

CONGREGATION: *After the meal, Jesus took a cup of wine in his hands and said, "This is my blood, and with it God makes his new agreement with you. Drink this and remember me."*

To walk circumspectly in the world; to be kind and just to those in our employ, and faithful in the service we promise others; endeavoring in the purity of heart and good will toward all men to exemplify and commend our holy faith.

We further engage to watch over, to pray for, to exhort and stir up each other unto every good word and work.

To guard each other's reputation, not needlessly exposing the infirmities of others; to participate in each other's joys and, with tender sympathy, bear one another's burdens and sorrows; to cultivate Christian courtesy;

To be slow to give or take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, being mindful of the rules of the Savior in the eighteenth chapter of Mathew, to secure it without delay; and through life, amid evil report and good report;

To seek the glory of God, who hath called us out of darkness into His marvelous light.

When we remove from this place we engage as soon as possible to unite with another church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's word.
